

TOUR BUS REGULATIONS

- Only tour busses affiliated to ATOA (Aruba Tour Operator Association) are allowed to conduct fixed daily operations on port premises
- ATOA must ensure an orderly daily rotation of buses Only two (2) busses are allowed to park at Terminal 6 (pier B) at stand 6A and 6B. The same is valid for Terminal 7 (pier C) stand 7A and 7B
- Maximum speed in the port area is 20 km / h.
- A maximum of 26 passengers is allowed per bus
- When there is more than one (1) ship in port only one (1) tour bus can sell tours at each pier
- A maximum of one (1) tour bus with one (1) driver and two (2) tour operators may be present at a terminal at one time
- ATOA members are not allowed to make any “taxi trips” other than upon request of Port Securities.
- Only tour operators with a valid badge to pick-up passengers on pre-paid tours may enter the terminals.
- All buses must remain on designated security areas
- All tour company staff must remain at their designated booth at all times
- Maximum speed in the port area is 20 km / h.
- Below please find a summary of the legal requirements established in accordance with DOPV that must be met by all drivers. When necessary APA will report infringements to DOPV and / or take the necessary measures.
- All ATOA members and bus drivers must:
- Be clean and dressed in a presentable manner (ATOA uniforms with ATOA logo);
- Refrain from rude or threatening behavior towards passengers;
- Not use, possess or be under the influence of alcohol during working hours;
- Not seek business by annoying or disturbing others in the area, or any other way seek to attract attention of others in a negative manner;
- Not charge passengers more than is stipulated in the (National Passenger Decree, General Provisions Art. 10 sections a, b, c, e, j)
- All professional drivers are subject to regulations stipulated by APA where applicable. APA NV will, if deemed necessary adapt these rules and
