Efrain Boekhoudt and Patrick Geerman were up in the lookout tower after 10:00 p.m. when they faintly heard calls from a Captain of a sailing vessel. After several attempts they were able to figure out the ship's exact location and with the cooperation of other partners they were able to bring in the vessel and its crew, 36 hours later. Both Matthew Church from Canada and Ronald Stocken from England were safe and sound. "This is the first time ever that a call is heard from this far away", according to Boekhoudt, a 32 year veteran at the port.

During a brief visit to the port earlier this month Boekhoudt and Geerman wished the men a speedy recovery and presented them with two gift baskets (courtesy of Aruba Aloe) containing some of the company's favorite formulas that are suited for delicate, sunburned skin. 
