DECKHAND

Primary duties & responsibility:

The Deckhand is responsible for securing the tug during berthing and unberthing operations, ensuring it is safely fastened to the docks and other vessels. The Deckhand is also responsible for the condition and reliability of the deck equipment by means of preventive maintenance. The Deckhand performs routine (household) activities such as cleaning and rinsing of the Tug (after every trip), chipping and painting, cleaning of the galley/ messroom/ accommodation/ restrooms/ wheelhouse and all remaining indoor facilities. The Deckhand forms part of the crew of APA's tugboat.

Qualifications:

Prospective candidates should meet the following requirements:

- ❖ EPB Level 2 in the technical field /MAVO degree;
- Sailing license (Kleinvaarbewijs) Aruba;
- First-Aid certificate and swimming certificate;
- Valid certificate of competency;
- Willing and able to work flexible hours when needed;
